COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PUBLICATION IS MANDATORY

ANGI 10-207, 1 July 1997, is supplemented as follows:

1.1.1. Approval and operational authority for unit directed CONUS flights is delegated by the Adjutant General to Air National Guard flying unit commanders.

1.1.2.1. (Added) Forward a copy of unit supplement to this instruction to Headquarters, California Air National Guard, Director of Operations (HQ CA ANG/DO).

*1.2.1. (Added) Governor's consent is required for California Air National Guard OCONUS movements or OCONUS training deployments in accordance with CA ANGI 36-2201, 24 Nov 96.

*1.3.1.4.1. (Added) As soon as possible following an operational tasking, the 129th Rescue Wing Commander, or his designated representative will notify HQ CA ANG/CS or DO of missions that include either helicopter extended overwater air refueling, helicopter night vision device, water personnel delivery/water hoist, helicopter rescue/support operations above 10,000 ft MSL, or pararescue parachute deployments. If required, ANG/CS or DO will notify the TAG and the CAPO Staff Duty Officer.
