ANGI 36-2005, 15 March 1999, is supplemented as follows:

4.2. (Added) The Military Personnel Flight is required to forward a minimum of two signed complete appointment packages to HQ CA ANG/DP for the following appointments:

- Transfer of ANGUS officers between states
- Transfer and appointment of Air Force Reserve and Regular Air Force officers

4.2.1. (Added) The Military Personnel Flight is required to forward a minimum of three signed complete appointment packages to HQ CA ANG/DP for the following appointment:

- Any appointment requiring an appointment waiver
- Professional appointments to include:
 - Judge Advocates (HQ USAF/JA approval)
 - Medical doctors
 - Early Commissioning Program Physicians
 - Chaplains
- Appointment of officers of other uniformed services and former officers, may be appointed temporarily
- Tenure-of-office appointments below general officer grades and reappointment of general officers, may be appointed temporarily

Attachment 5, Rule 16 (Added) The forms/letters listed below are required to be completed when transferring ANGUS officers between states:

- Commander's approving endorsement
- SF Form 88/93
- AF Form 2030
- Current Records Review RIP
- AF Form 1288/DD Form 368
- CAL NG 600-2

10.2. (Added) An approving/disapproving endorsement is required from the losing State Headquarter's when transferring an ANGUS officer into California.
